 Information for schools and colleges regarding educational products and related items (SLC)

General Public Access

- Meetings
 - Timetable of RoPACS meetings
 - Summary of past meetings
 - Agenda
 - Participants (photos)
 - Presentations
 - Summary of outcomes
- Publications and press releases

- Password protected area
- People (more detail)
 - A detailed description for each RoPACS member
 - Affiliation
 - Describe the persons role in the network
 - Information on their research area
 - Publications
 - Contact information (email, phone number etc)

- Candidate transit tables
 - List of candidates together with information on their positions, transit times and dates
 - Information could be useful to RoPACS members with observing time
 - May prove to be a very useful tool for gathering data on candidate sources
- Most likely to be managed by myself

- Observing timetable for RoPACS members
 - Optional feature for the members only area
 - RoPACS members can request
 - People may have a new candidate that is not yet on the website.
 - People may wish to ask a favour and request a portion of someone's observing time to observe a candidate (in return for some of their time at a later date)
- This will also be administered by me

- Educational product development
 - Area dedicated to prototype ideas for educational products
 - Important to keep in members only area so other people don't take credit for ideas that are still in development
 - Idea is to include information on the product itself together with ways in which it may be used for educational purposes
- This will also be maintained by me
